Monday: Labor Day Psalm 127 Pray in this Psalm, asking God to be part of all your labors.

Tuesday: Matthew 9:35-38 Where are you today - part of the crowd that is harassed and helpless, or are you part of the labor crew that is helping those who are harassed and helpless? Pray that God brings you His peace so that you may go out into the crowd and help where help is needed.

Wednesday: Proverbs 6:6-8 Be The Ant! Do you ever stop and just watch ants? Probably not; most of us are trying to rid our homes of those pesky insects. Pesky in the home, but as a life example, they are tenacious, industrious, go above and beyond what it appears they can do, and always seem to find a way to their goal. So maybe this is good advice...be the ant! Pray for God to give you the energy and perseverance so that you, too, can be the ant.

Thursday: 1 Corinthians 3 Paul gets right to the heart of the matter – our heart – our stubbornness to stay in the flesh – our tendency to lift human leaders and/or ourselves above others. Pray that you are able to humble yourself so that you keep Jesus as your foundation, and build God's kingdom, not man's kingdom.

Friday: 1 Corinthians 15:56-58 Pray in these verses asking God to strengthen you, giving you courage and peace in your service to God.

Saturday: Hebrews 6:10-12 Pray that you may labor in love for your fellow person and walk daily with the God of pure love.

Sunday: Matthew 20:1-15 These verses sure set our fleshy, envious nature in overdrive. When we consider these verses simply as vineyard works and cold, hard cash, our sense of fairness gets in a frenzy. But what about our spiritual side? Do we look and treat those who have not grown up believing in Christ-saving grace less than us? Do we think we have a greater reward for 'sticking it out for the long run'? Pray through this story, asking God to reach deep into your heart and vanquish envy.
